Spring Flower Pick-up

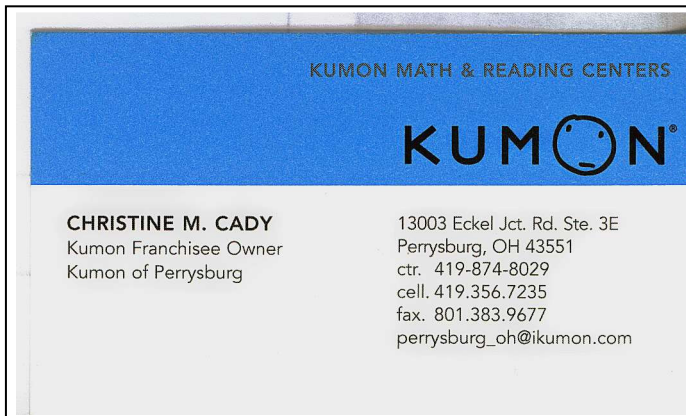
